Word Tips
Navigation: use different fonts/headers so that document is navigable.
Header row repeat: if table breaks across a page, repeats headers on that subsequent page.
Widow/Orphan: if paragraph breaks across a page or column, at least 2 lines will be kept together at the beginning and the end.
